



Dear partner,

I am contacting you in order to inform you about an initiative of the University of Granada, associated to the long standing cooperation activities organized by our university in the city of Mostar.

The 2015 UGR's International Cooperation Plan offers a scholarship for a graduate of the University of Mostar to study a Master's degree (60 ECTS) at the University of Granada for the academic year 2015-2016. We hope that this initiative will be of your interest.

Find below the details regarding the requirements for candidates, the conditions of the scholarship and the necessary administrative process.

Applicants must,

- be nationals of Bosnia Herzegovina
- have obtained a University degree that gives access to Master level studies.
- have sufficient knowledge of the language of instruction of the corresponding Master's programme (Spanish or English).

Conditions of the grant

The maximum duration of the grant is ten (10) months. The selected candidate may prepare his/her Master's thesis or the practicum (should the latter be required by the programme) in Mostar, if s/he decides to deliver it September.

The selected grantee will follow the standard admission procedure and enrol as regular master's students at the UGR. Once all academic and administrative requirements are fulfilled, the students will obtain an official master's degree and the corresponding diploma supplement.

Selection

The University of Mostar will propose a candidate, taking under consideration the Academic Excellence and the linguistic competence of the candidates. The name of the proposed candidate will be sent to the Development Cooperation Centre of the University of Granada ([dircicode@ugr.es](mailto:dircicode@ugr.es) and [admoncicode@ugr.es](mailto:admoncicode@ugr.es)), before the 17 of July 2015, together with the following documents, in order to ensure that all formal requirements are fulfilled:

- Transcript of Records including General Point Average (translated into Spanish or English).
- Diploma of the degree that gives access to Master's level studies (translated into Spanish or English).

- Official certificate of the language of instruction. Minimum level required B1. Some programmes may have established higher admission requirements. The candidate must check the master's web site for the required language and the corresponding level. You can find the language proficiency certificates accepted by UGR in the following link:

The scholarship will cover the following costs:



- Tuition fees
- One Return ticket (Economy class) from the city of origin to the destination up to a maximum of 700€
- 600€ allowance per month for the duration of the stay (accommodation and subsistence)
- Degree issuing Administrative fees
- Mandatory Insurance policy fees

The acceptance of the scholarship by the selected applicant involves the commitment to the academic requirements of the corresponding study programme. Moreover, the grantee will assume any costs not covered by the scholarship.

We trust that this proposal is of your interest, in our desire to continue the long standing cooperation initiated in the Joint Centre in 2005.
